A BY-LAW TO PRESCRIBE A RATE OF SPEED ON COUNTY ROAD NO. 23

WHEREAS Section 128(2) of the Highway Traffic Act, RSO 1990, Chapter H.8. provides that the council of a municipality may, by by-law, prescribe a rate of speed of 40, 50, 60, 70, 80, 90 or 100 kilometres per hour;

AND WHEREAS it is deemed expedient to reduce the speed limit on County Road No. 23, in the Village of Merrickville/Wolford.

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Corporation of the United Counties of Leeds and Grenville enacts as follows:

1. When any portion of County Road No. 23 set out in Columns 1 and 2 below are marked in compliance with the regulations of the Highway Traffic Act, the maximum rate of speed therein shall be the rate of speed set out opposite thereto in Column 3.

<u>Column 1</u> <u>From</u>	<u>Column 2</u> <u>To</u>	<u>Column 3</u> <u>Rate of Speed</u>
West Intersection of County Road 23 and County Road 43	3.6 km Easterly to of North Grenville	60 km/hr

2. The penalties provided in Subsection (14) of Section 128 of the Highway Traffic Act shall apply to offences against the by-law.

By-law read a first, second and third time and finally passed this 22nd day of January, 2004.
